The Early Career Framework Programme Information



Overview

The ECF programme is a two-year blended offer for Early Career Teachers, that includes small group sessions with experienced teachers in Tower Hamlets and Hackney. ECTs work in clusters led by facilitators who are subject/phase specialists in their area. Teachers on the programme have the opportunity to join a local network of 1,000 ECTs and mentors.

What does the programme involve?

Year 1	Year 2
In Year One you will focus on the content from the Early Career Framework.	Year Two of the programme focuses on engaging in a series of personal professional inquiries with your mentor to develop your practice further.
You will meet your cluster every half term for: two-hour in-person afternoon sessions for one- hour Online Learning Community sessions	You will meet with local teachers for 4 two - hour cluster sessions in each half-term in Autumn and Spring.
In addition, you will have your own self- directed study activities and meet every week with your mentor	You will have your own self-directed study activities and meet your mentor every other week.
	In the Summer term you will undertake focused visits to other schools to broaden your experiences.

Mentor programme

The 36-hour **Mentor programme** is offered through a blend of in-person sessions, online learning communities and self-study. The programme focuses on developing your research-informed mentoring expertise and will help you navigate the ECF programme.

Who are we?

The East London Teaching School Hub, through an ethos of collegiality, inclusion and transparency ensures every teacher has equal access to a clear and all-compassing pathway of professional development. The Hub, in partnership with UCL Institute of Education (our lead provider) and a consortium of strategic partners across Tower Hamlets and Hackney, takes the lead in the Early Career Framework programme. Currently, there are more than 1,000 Early Career Teachers (ECTs) and mentors participating in the programme, representing 140 schools.
